The Department of Economics, Society and Politics of the University of Urbino, in collaboration with the CSEAR Italy, is delighted to welcome the 7th Italian Conference on Social and Environmental Accounting Research (CSEAR Italy 2018) “Accounting, Accountability and Society” that will be held in Urbino on 20th and 21st September 2018 and will be preceded by the 2nd CSEAR Italy Doctoral Colloquium (September 19th, 2018).

The CSEAR Italy conferences, which have been organized bi-annually since 2006, provide an interdisciplinary forum for encouraging debate in social and environmental accounting and accountability and presenting research ideas, emerging projects and working/full papers in a friendly and supportive environment.

Submissions procedure

Participants are kindly invited to submit abstracts (no more than 500 words plus references) of research projects, working and full papers to the following email address: csearitaly2018@uniurb.it.

Works and projects could be submitted and discussed in English. It is important to note that the submitted works/papers should be anonymous. The following information should be included in a separate file:

- Title of the contribution
- Author(s) and organization affiliation (e.g. university, department, organization, etc.)
- Contact Information (address, telephone, fax, e-mail etc.)
- Type of contribution (full papers, papers in progress, ideas for research project, thesis in progress)
- References

Publishing/Editorial opportunities

All papers/abstract will be peer-reviewed prior to acceptance for the Conference. We suggest to submit papers to Social and Environmental Accountability Journal. A number of papers, dealing with topics related to Social Accounting and Governance ,will be selected for eligibility of submission to Journal of Management and Governance following a fast-track review process for publication (<http://link.springer.com/journal/10997>) .

In addition, a number of papers will be eligible for submission to: *Piccola Impresa/Small Business* (<http://rivistapiccolaimpresa.uniurb.it>), fast-track review process for publication; *International Journal of Corporate Social Responsibility* (Springer Open Access Journal, <https://jcsr.springeropen.com/> ISSN: 2366-0066, print version; ISSN: 2366-0074, electronic version. Accepted papers will also be eligible for publication in: a book planned in the Springer Series, *CSR, Sustainability, Ethics & Governance* (<http://www.springer.com/series/11565>) and in a book planned with Cambridge Scholars Publishing Ltd (www.cambridgescholars.com).
