In an international context, where young researchers have to develop and share knowledge since the beginning of their academic career, the SIDREA - EAA DOCTORAL COLLOQUIUM aims to provide an opportunity for PhD students to present, share and discuss their research projects with a distinguished international faculty.

All topics and research methodologies consistent with the SIDREA National Conference are considered appropriate for the DOCTORAL COLLOQUIUM. Based on a peer review perspective, the colloquium consists of an individual discussion of the research projects accepted for presentation.

PhD students who are carrying out a research project related to the topic of the conference are invited to participate. Only PhD Students attending the second or third year of their PhD Program can apply for the Doctoral Colloquium.

The DOCTORAL COLLOQUIUM will take place online in the English Language on **October 20th**.

To apply for the DOCTORAL COLLOQUIUM the following documents has to be emailed to Prof. Stefano Azzali (stefano.azzali@unipr.it) by September 10th, 2022:

- an abstract of at least 3,000 words or a paper (in English) between 5,000 and 8,000 words (co-produced works with senior lecturers are not accepted);
- Curriculum Vitae.
- a short description of the entire research project.

The contributions will be evaluated by a joint commission SIDREA - EAA of the Doctoral Colloquium and the acceptance will be communicated by September 30th, 2022.

Three (3) PhD students that will take part in the Doctoral Colloquium will be selected and awarded the following benefits:

- two years of free EAA membership, providing free access to the EAA journals (European Accounting Review and Accounting in Europe) and to the entire EAA-ARC website;
- a reduction on the Congress fee (not combinable with any other discount applied to PhD students' registration);
- free attendance to the EAA PhD Forum within the EAA annual congress (2023, May)
- the opportunity to submit their PhD proposal to the ARC Peer Mentoring Initiative (<https://www.arc-eea.com/peer-mentoring-initiative>). Students should inform the EAA Executive Secretary and the EAA National Associations Management Committee member when submitting the proposal to the ARC Peer Mentoring Initiative.

Please note that it is possible to send both a contribution to the DOCTORAL COLLOQUIUM and to the SIDREA Congress at the same time.

Registration to the Doctoral Colloquium is free.
